	Exhaust	Is the vehicle noise level acceptable? Does exhaust system clear the vehicle body appropriately?			
	Battery:	Is battery secured with proper clamp? Are terminals covered? Blue triangle to identify location?			
	Body:	Are all panels secure (doors, bonnet, boot, etc)? Is there any excessive or unsafe body damage?			
	General interior:	Is the inside of the vehicle free of loose items? Is the windscreen clear and free of damage?			
	Wheels/Tyres:	Are road tyres fitted and safe for use? Are wheels on tight? Is there any play in wheel bearings?			
	Helmet/s:	Are they to appropriate standard? Are they in good condition (no excessive scuffing or damage)?
